

80 acres of land, NW of NE and NE of NW of Section 14-7-10 from B. L. Price.,...\$4000.00

20 head of thorough bred white faced cattle valued at \$100.00 each from R. M. McFarlin ...\$2000.00

700 bushels of corn at \$1.00 ner bushel .: \$700.00 from Roxie A. Chapman.

800 bales of hay at 40% ner bale....\$320.00 from John Sherry.

Hardware from C. E. Arnold.....178.15

Christmas money ..... 3600.00

If you will remember, I have taken this up with you which was at the time I was in Washington. You told me to locate the cattle, corn and land and resent the bill to you. I am furnishing the Indian Agent of Holdenville and Muskogee with copy of same.
